Dalmatian Coast – Croatia - September 16th - 26th 2017

Join Afterguard Sailing on a Flotilla Adventure along the Dalmatian Coast. Fly into Venice for one night then ferry to Pula to begin sailing.

Northern Route (PULA):

Day 1: Pula -> Medulin (16.3NMI)



Isola di Levan is one of best beaches in Istria. Known for its Lovely white sand and beautiful blue sea #1 per Tripadvisor



Day 2: Medulin → Cres (22.4Nmi)

Cres - Among the most notable attractions in Cres is the freshwater lake of Vrana. This unique natural phenomenon is actually one of the deepest freshwater lakes in Eastern Europe. Secluded beaches and fantastic Scuba Diving and snorkeling await here!



Day 3: Cres -> Krk (36.4Nmi)

Krk is known as the 'Golden Island'. The southern tip of the island offers gentle bays for anchoring. Popular activities on Krk include diving, jet skiing, waterskiing, and paragliding. A Majestic castle stands on this island! The 12th century castle was once the final line of the city's defenses. A square tower served as a court. The seafront tower is amazing for its architecture. The views from the top of the city walls are stellar.



Day 4: Krk -> Rab (21.3Nmi)

Komrčar Park is a preserve for many plants and trees, including a 100-year old agave. Due to more than 300 freshwater springs on the island, Rab is one of the greenest islands in the Adriatic Sea. The warm summers and mild winters make Rab an excellent place to visit any time of the year.



Day 5: Rab -> Lošinj (17.6NMi)

More like an Island Chain. The Tower of Veli Lošinj is a main attraction in the beautiful town. Enjoy the amazing views from the top of the tower. There is a museum is hidden in a center of the town.

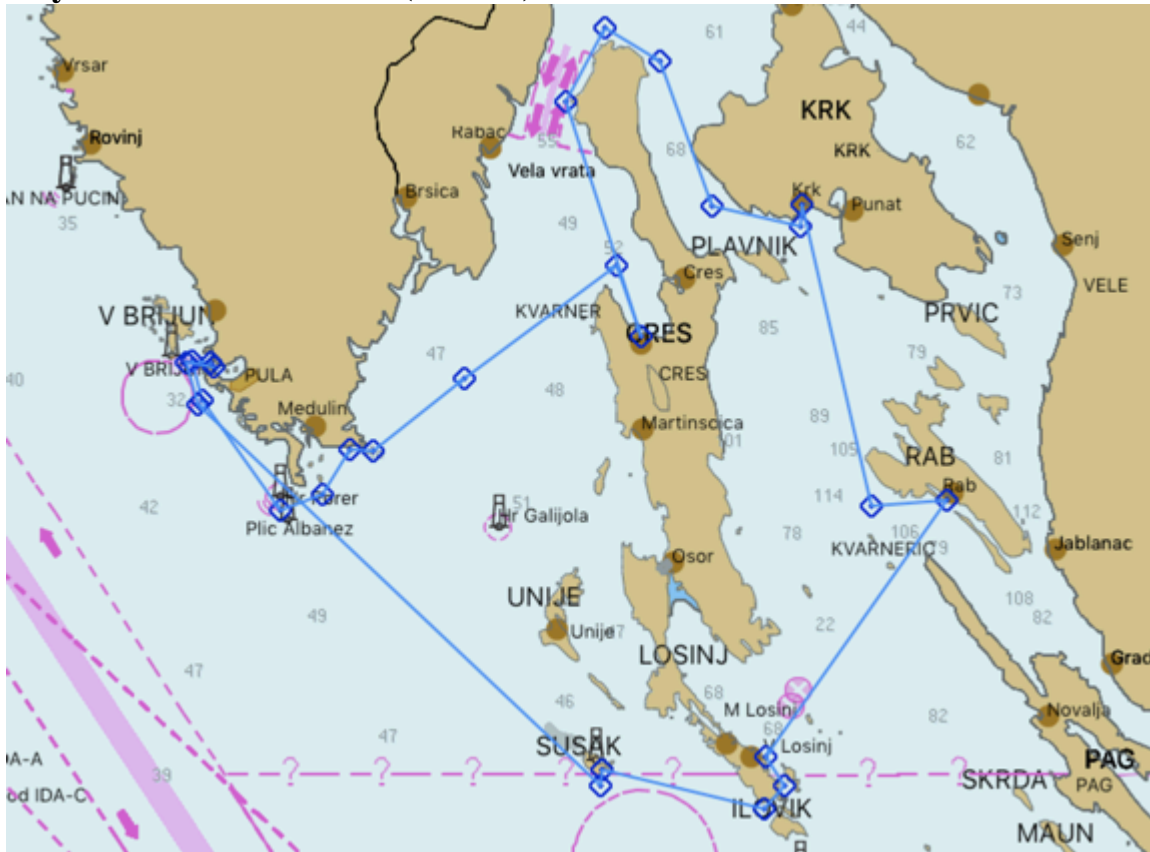


Day 6: Losinj → Susak 127 (13Nmi)

Gornje Selo - Island Susak - Gornje selo, an island and village without cars. You just simple enjoy the sun, the nature and a warm and clear sea.



Day 7: Susak – Pula 127 (34Nmi)

The sea currents in the Adriatic are warm. They move from the south of Croatia to the north, and along the Italian coast from the north to the south.

The Croatian part of the Adriatic sea is considered the cleanest in Europe.

The natural beauty and picturesqueness of the Croatian coastline is accentuated by the mild Mediterranean climate, with between 2,400 and 2,800 hours of sunshine per year, which makes it one of the sunniest coastlines in Europe.

Base Cost approx. **\$2395**, double cabin rate. Actual cost to be refined. Expect this sailing vacation total \$3500.

Base Cost is a factor of boat rental fee. Travel; Round trip to Venice is currently as low as \$500 book early. The ferry across to Pula is \$110 each way. Two nights stay in Venice \$20-250. Provisions - anticipate \$300 pp. Plan to sail with the group in SF Bay before the trip.
